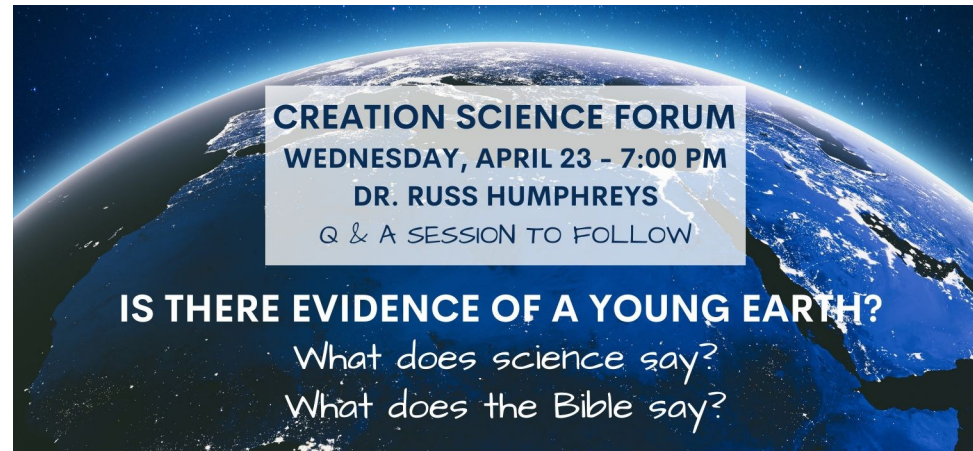
For your convenience, hearing assistance devices are
